

4. Mentor and mentee will attend together (if work and personal schedules allow) any Chapter sponsored ARC activity (drill, exercise) occurring during the three-month duration of this agreement
5. Mentee will be invited to attend Response Committee meetings or other ARC-sponsored meetings that Mentor attends during the three-month period
6. Mentor will involve mentee in Health Services sponsored activities such as review of district Health Services supplies or appropriate classes and trainings
7. When mentor is "on-call" for Health Services, requests by DAT or caseworkers for Health Services support will be shared with mentee; solutions and follow-up will be the joint responsibility of mentor and mentee working collaboratively to assist the client.
8. Should there be an incident requiring the opening of a shelter or other district or Chapter-wide response activity, mentor will work with Staffing Services to schedule mentor/mentee for the same shift in the same ARC location, if possible. Mentor will coach mentee and provide technical and personal support in the shelter or other ARC location.

Mentorship Program Agreement

I understand that the Health Services Mentorship Program offered by the American Red Cross, Greater Los Angeles Chapter, is voluntary.

1. The Supervisor, Health Services, will attempt to match appropriate Mentors and Mentees; however, it is the responsibility of each participant to take responsibility for the success of the mentoring relationship and to assure the Program meets their personal and volunteer goals.
2. I agree to respect the time of my Mentor/Mentee and give adequate notice if I reschedule meetings or telephone appointments.
3. At any time, I can contact Mary Chasin, RN, Supervisor Health Services to discuss any questions or concerns that I have about the Mentorship Program.
